Mark Twain is one of the most popular American authors. His real name was Samuel Clemens and he lived from 1835 to 1910. He wrote many books. His two most famous books are *Tom Sawyer* and *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn*. Both of these books are about boys growing up in a small town beside the Mississippi River. Samuel Clemens grew up in that kind of town. In these books, he wrote a lot about his own life as a boy.

When Clemens was a teenager, he left school and went to work as a printer. After that, he worked on a boat on the Mississippi River. In the 1860s, Clemens went to California where he worked as a writer. As a writer, he used the name Mark Twain instead of his real name. "Mark twain" was an expression that he had learned while he was working on a boat on the Mississippi River. This expression meant that the water was deep enough for boats to pass safely.

Clemens became famous because people liked his books and stories very much.

The Invention^{*} of the Popsicle^{**}

- (1) Did you know that the popsicle was invented in 1905 by an elevenyear-old boy? Like many inventors, Frank Epperson made his discovery by accident. One day, Frank was mixing a drink with a stick. He left the drink outside overnight with the stick still in it.
- (5) That night the temperature dropped and his drink froze. The next day Frank saw what had happened. He picked up the stick and tasted the frozen drink. It was really good!

In 1923, Frank decided to sell his frozen drinks in different fruit flavors. He named his invention the "Epsicle." Later, his children (10) changed the name to "popsicle."

Today, people still eat popsicles. Over one billion popsicles are sold in the United States each year! They are made in more than 30 different flavors. But orange has always been the favorite.

J.K. Rowling

When she was a child, Joanne Kathleen Rowling loved reading books and making up stories of her own. When she was five, she wrote her first story, "Rabbit." In high school, her favorite activity was telling long, complicated stories to her friends.

When she grew up, Rowling continued to write. One day in the summer of 1990, she was on a long train ride. She suddenly had an idea for a book about a boy named Harry Potter who discovers that he is a wizard. Four hours later, when Rowling got off the train, she knew what the story would be about.

Rowling, who was divorced and the mother of a small baby, did not have a job and had very little money. Her tiny apartment was very cold. During the day Rowling would take her daughter to a café and write while the baby slept next to her. When she finished the book, she started sending it to publishers. In the beginning, no one wanted to publish it. But in June 1997, *Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone* finally appeared. The book was an instant success. More than a million books were sold. Rowling wrote more Harry Potter books. They were all translated into many different languages and enjoyed by children and adults around the world.
